## Supplementary Water Access for NSW Murray and Lower Darling Valleys

7 July 2026

NSW Department of Climate Change, Energy, the Environment and Water -Water Group has approved access to supplementary water in the Regulated Murray River System due to rain and translucent releases in the catchment. The river sections for which supplementary access has been made available are shown below in page two & three.

In addition, all regulated river (general security) access licence holders may take water during this period of supplementary flows, if the uncontrolled flow (UCF) limits of their accounts permit. Licence holders are reminded that all diversions count towards the annual usage limit of 100% of entitlement (excludes trades into accounts).

The supplementary access is available to limited sections of the Wakool/Yallakool system where water is available after river refilling. The supplementary access is not available to other sections where the system is not fully connected yet.

Customers wishing to access supplementary water must provide a START meter reading and place a complying water order using one of the following options:

Customers are reminded that with the conclusion of supplementary access an END meter reading must be provided, and as regulated flow conditions would resume, water orders must be placed in accordance with their licence conditions.

WaterNSW will continue to monitor the situation closely and further advice, if required, will be issued on or before **Thursday 9 July 2026**.
